


If you would like to sign up to sponsor the sanctuary flowers call the office at 423-753-3942 to reserve your Sunday.

Women can wash up to two loads of laundry, take a shower to refresh themselves, make phone calls and receive resource referrals. The River also hosts Diaper Days every other Wednesday and families are able to stop by and pick up free diapers and wipes for their children.
