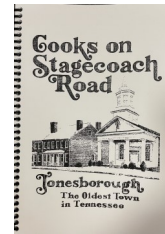


The flowers today have been provided by Ashley & Judy Whitehurst in honor of God and Judy's Birthday (9/21).

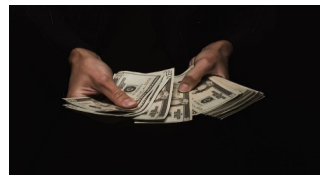

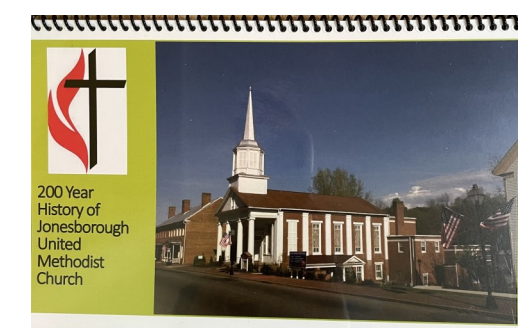
