## Welcome to Angie Huffine . . .

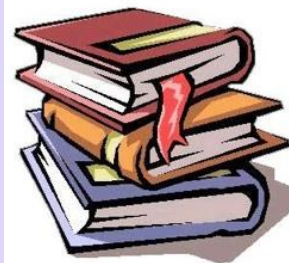

## Statements of Giving



We have been accustomed to receiving a “statement of giving” annually for tax purposes. This year, our Financial Secretary will be sending these statements on a quarterly basis to all persons who make contributions to the Church. This should help each of us stay on track with our financial stewardship and take appropriate action to keep our giving up-to-date and increase our giving as necessary to support the ministries of our Church.

Remember, God’s expectation is that *tithing* is our *minimum* stewardship response to God’s most generous love for us, and *tithing plus* is our goal for the Gospel work here and around the world.

## Financial Stewardship Update

This year, 2015, we have in place as Jonesborough UMC a ministry spending plan of \$451,999. We did not pledge or in any other way declare how we would underwrite this plan. So we hope and pray that we all know what we need to do, that we all take tithing seriously, and that we all give generously to the Lord's work in and through our church.

Our church expenses vary by month, just as our own personal expenses do. There are certain fixed expenses that we must pay each month. After only two months, however, JUMC is already \$6,702 "in the hole" on a let's-get-by basis. Our financial stewardship, as we begin 2015, really needs a shot in the arm. A thumbnail sketch looks like this:

Johnson City District's goal for this year's **Conference Hands-On Project** is to provide 400 backpacks for Methodist work in our schools in Liberia. Our church has set a goal of providing 50 backpacks. Your monetary donation will enable us to buy backpacks and Bibles in bulk and to mail the backpacks once we fill them.
