The River is a non-profit ministry located at 125 W. Main St in Johnson City that seeks to provide services and support to women and children. The River works hard to provide services that are not offered anywhere else in Johnson City. Many places offer food and clothing to people in need, The River is unique in its offering of laundry facilities and showers. Women can wash up to two loads of laundry, take a shower to refresh themselves, make phone calls and receive resource referrals. The River also hosts Diaper Days every other Wednesday and families are able to stop by and pick up free diapers and wipes for their children. Donations of diapers and wipes are welcome and can be dropped off in the Fellowship Hall or money can be donated. Be sure to put on your check in the memo line "The River".

Items needed are: laundry detergent, bleach, diapers –size 4-5-6, individual snacks, coffee, cream & sugar packets, coffee filters, and bottled water.
