ASP is a Christian ministry that is open to all people and provides home repair and replacement for low-income families in rural Appalachia. They have committed to building 200 homes in our area as part of their **Help After Helene** program. As part of **Rebuild Embreeville** Colonial Heights UMC, Camp Bays Mountain, Jonesborough UMC, First UMC in Johnson City, Mafair UMC, and ETSU Wesley Foundation are working together to raise the \$50,000 gap funding per home for five homes. Currently, enough money has been raised for three homes. The youth from JUMC will be going to Kentucky for a week in June to work with ASP.
