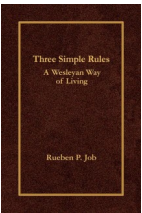

MyRide TN is a senior-friendly volunteer transportation service that has taken root in Tennessee. Volunteer drivers use their personal vehicles to carry older Tennesseans to a variety of destinations, including medical appointments and grocery stores (Monday–Friday) with priority given to doctor appointments. Our local office serves people in the Jonesborough and Johnson City areas. Each rider pays a \$20.00 yearly membership fee and then pays a \$5.00 fee for each door -to-door round-trip ride. This month’s mission will help provide scholarship monies for those in need who cannot afford the signup fee or ride.
